# A FIRST FOR SOUTH AMERICA

In 2016, Rio de Janeiro will be the first
South American country to ever host the Summer Games.

### **SUMMER GAMES HISTORY**

The first Summer Games were held in 1896 in Athens, Greece.

It was the largest organized ever at the time, with only 245 competitors and 14 countries represented.

#### **EVENTS & COMPETITORS**

The Olympics have increased from a 42-event competition with fewer than 250 male athletes from 14 nations to a 300-event sporting celebration with over 10,000 competitors from 205 nations.
